# SU Tech Session

Our May meeting was held at Blair Engle's. We advertised a SU carb tech session and invited members of the North Florida British Motoring Club and The Temple of Triumph. Members were asked to drive their British Sports Cars. Late arrivals found a display of 1 MG TD, 1 MG A, several MG Bs, an MG Midget, a Bug Eye Sprite, a TR-4 and an 07 Mini Cooper displayed on the lawn. Later inspection revealed no dead grass from oil drips. Thanks guys!

The session started with a demonstration of how to repair stripped 8mm X 1 threaded holes in Art Ayotts MG TD aluminum oil pan.

Next came the SU carbs. We started with a hand out, showing a cutaway drawing of an SU carb. We discussed the theory of how the dashpot piston, needle, jet, throttle and vacuum made the carb work.

We displayed examples of H-2 and H-4s, HD and HS SU carbs and how they differed. We then disassembled one HS-4 MG-B carb and discussed what would be needed to restore it. We next installed new bushings and shaft on and already cleaned carb and proceeded to completely assemble it.

While us guys were out in the garage doing our SU thing, the ladies were in the house doing what ladies do when they get together. T\_l\_i\_g. They did keep us well supplied with hot coffee and donuts.

After the tech session, we all retired to the house where the ladies had prepared a bountiful display of salads and desserts, which we all enjoyed. Thank you ladies!!!!

# MGB Boot/Trunk Emergency Release

In my article on the bonnet release I said I would post if I figured out a boot release. I did some experimenting and have installed one in my 74 MGB that works. I wanted to avoid having the release cable exposed to the storage area in the boot. I was almost successful but there is a small loop just behind the latch, I think it will not be a problem. The materials I used were a small piece of 1/8" galvanized metal, A used MGB bonnet release



The Boot Latch

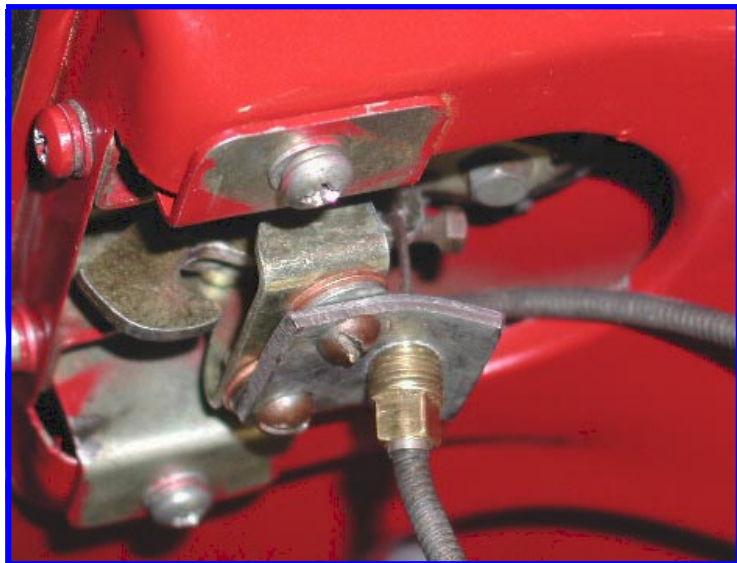
cable I pulled from a parts car, a 1/8"-27 brass pipe plug and two small screws with nuts and washers. Tools needed are a drill and some bits, basic hand tools, hack saw, a good vise helps, and a 1/8" pipe tap. The release is for locks that are opened with a push button as used on MGB's.

The latch assembly should be removed to provide access. I drilled a 1/8" hole in the latch lever near the top where the push button contacts the lever. I used a length of 1/8" thick 1" wide galvanized steel for a cable bracket. It's easier to drill all the holes before cutting

the bracket to the correct length, it is about 1 1/4" long, it's not a critical dimension. Drill two 1/4" holes in the end of the bracket to fit the existing holes in the latch frame. Mark the bracket at the edge of the latch metal frame. Place the bracket in a vise and bend it at the mark. The bend should be around 15 degrees, you want the bracket bent so that the cable will be pointing toward the hole in latch lever. Use a 11/32" drill to drill the

hole for the 1/8"-27 brass pipe plug, this hole needs to be close to the latch frame to get the correct position for the cable to align with the hole in the lever. Use a 1/8"-27 pipe tap to make threads in the bracket. Screw in the brass plug and drill a 1/8" hole through it, try to get the hole in the center. Now you need to drill a counter sink hole almost through the plug to retain the cable sheath, the bonnet cable I used required a 13/64" drill. I installed the cable in the rear bulkhead on the drivers side, I wanted it to come through near the top of the boot area. I ran the cable through the boot lid frame and it's currently held in place with some strips of pipe insulation

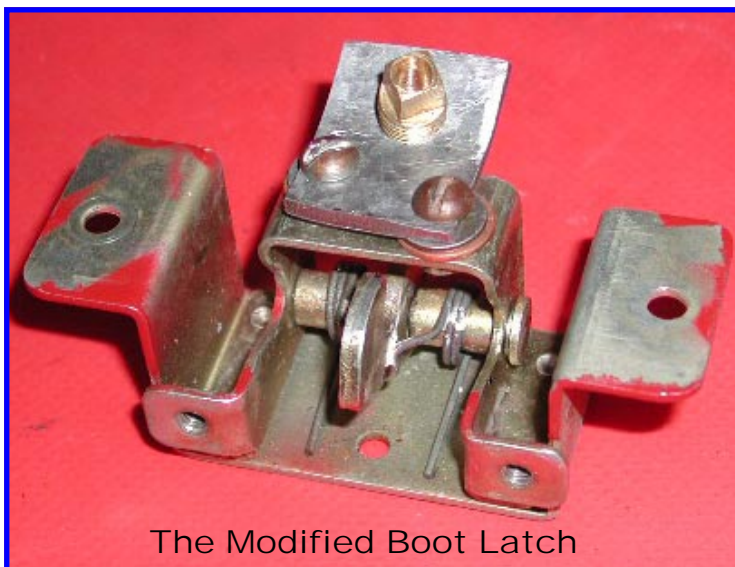

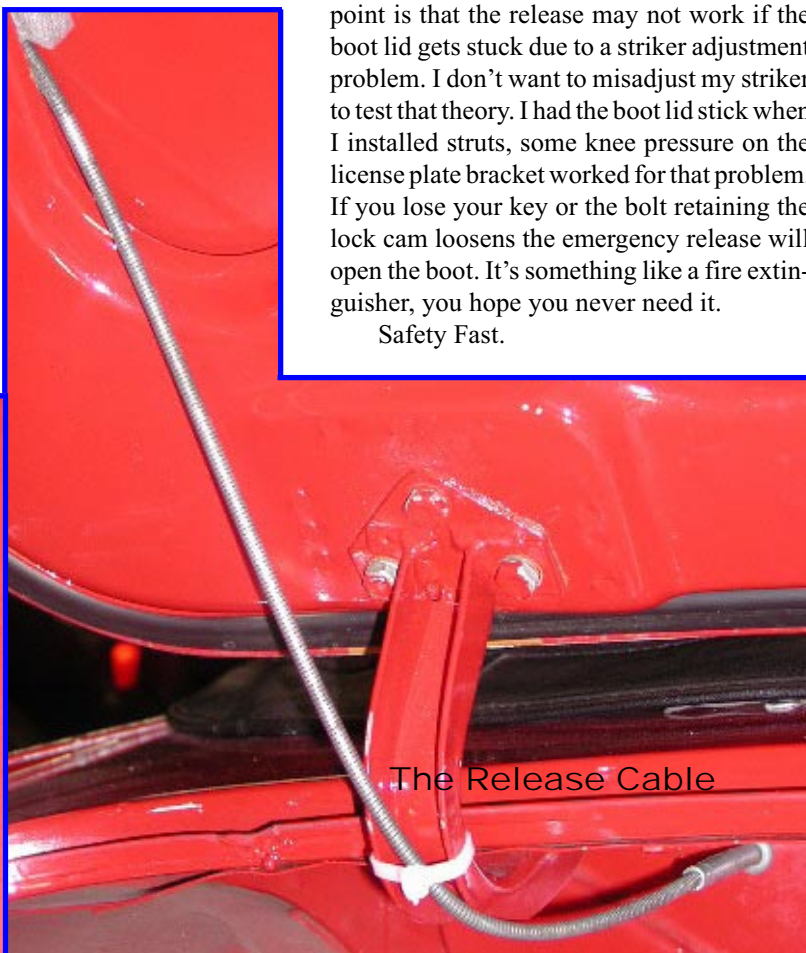
foam. I used a nylon tie to secure the cable to the boot hinge.

The photos will show where everything fits. There are a couple of points to consider before installing an emergency release. One is security, since I have the release knob on the bulkhead behind the drive seat it could be opened by someone interested in the boot contents. It may never be a problem because it isn't supposed to have a release. The second point is that the release may not work if the boot lid gets stuck due to a striker adjustment problem. I don't want to misadjust my striker to test that theory. I had the boot lid stick when I installed struts, some knee pressure on the license plate bracket worked for that problem. If you lose your key or the bolt retaining the lock cam loosens the emergency release will open the boot. It's something like a fire extinguisher, you hope you never need it.

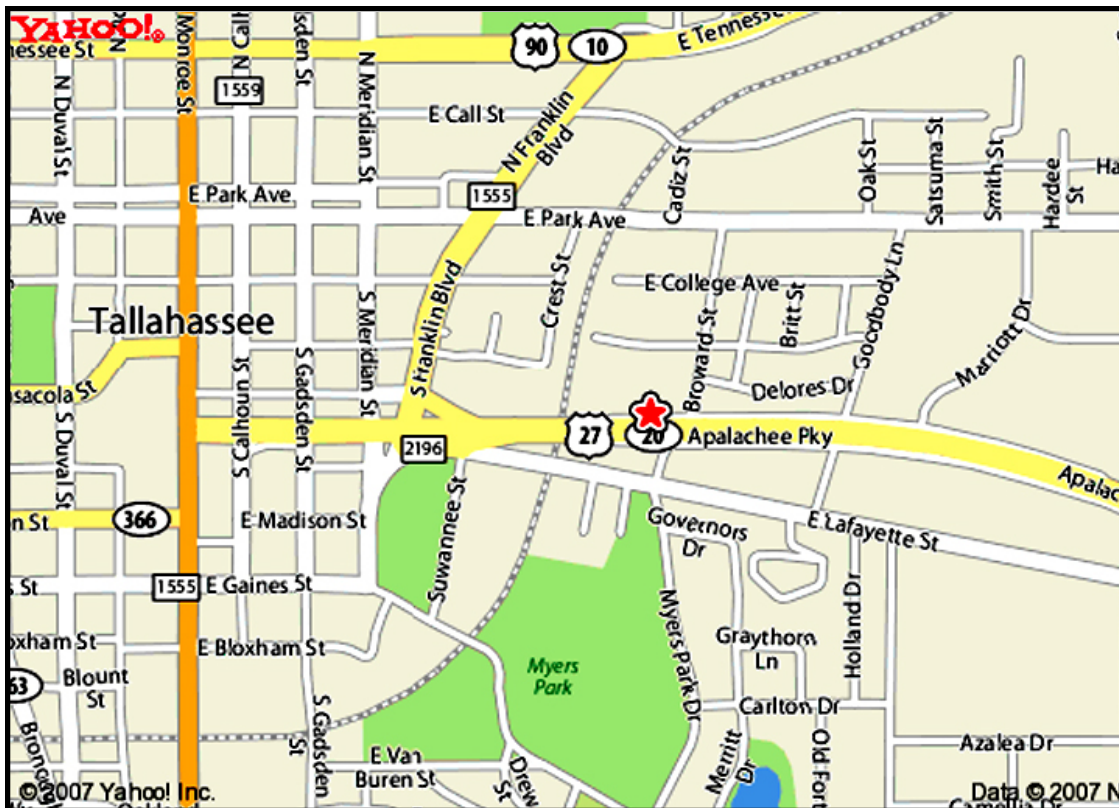


The Modified Boot Latch
